# **BERNAT OWL CROCHET SUPER SCARF** | CROCHET







## MATERIALS

**Bernat® Softee Chunky™** (3.5 oz /100 g; 108 yds/99 m)

Contrast A Emerald (28200)
Contrast B Seagreen (28219)
Contrast C Natural (28008)
Contrast D Glowing Gold (28607)
1 ball

Optional: Approx 10 yds/9 m White (28005) or use Natural for Eyes.

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 

4 black buttons for eyes.

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] x 100" [254 cm].

#### **GAUGE**

9 sc and 10 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Note:** Scarf is made in 2 pieces then seamed in center.

To join colors, work to last loops on hook of first color, draw new color through last loops and proceed.

**SCARF HALF** (make 2)

## **OWL**

With C, ch 4.

**1st rnd:** 13 dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch-3 counts as dc). Join with sl st to top of ch-4. 14 dc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each dc around. Join B with sl st to first sc. 28 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. Skip next sc. \*2 sc in next sc. Skip next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Ch 2. Skip next sc. \*1 sc in next sc. Ch 2. Skip next sc. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc.

**5th rnd:** SI st in first ch-2 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. \*3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. Fasten off. **6th rnd:** Join A with sl st to first ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 4. \*1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 4. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to first sc.

**7th rnd:** SI st in first ch-4 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 3 dc in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. \*4 dc in next ch-4 sp. Ch 1. Rep from \* around. Join with sl st to top of ch-3.



## BERNAT OWL CROCHET SUPER SCARF | CROCHET

**8th rnd:** SI st in each of next 3 dc and ch-1 sp. Ch 1. 1 sc in same ch-1 sp as last sl st. Skip first 2 dc. 6 dc in next dc – Scallop made. Skip next dc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. (Skip next 2 dc. Scallop in next dc. Skip next dc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp) 9 times. Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 1 sc in next dc. (Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc) twice. 1 sc in next dc. 1 hdc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in first dc of rnd. **Do not** fasten off. **Turn.** 

#### **SCARF**

Beg working in rows as follows:

**1st row:** (WS). Ch 3 (counts as dc). V-st in next dc. (Skip next st. V-st in next st) 7 times. Skip next st. 1 dc in top of ch-3. 8 V-sts. Turn.

**2nd row:** (RS). Ch 3 (counts as dc). V-st in each V-st to end of row. 1 dc in last dc. Turn.

Rep last row working in the following Stripe pat:

With B: 2 rows. With C: 1 row. With A: 7 rows.

These 10 rows form Stripe pat.

Cont in Stripe pat until work from beg measures approx 50" [127 cm], ending on a 3rd row of A for first piece and 4th row of A for 2nd piece. Fasten off.

Sew last row of 2 Scarf Halves tog using mattress st.

#### EYES (make 2)

With C (or optional White yarn), ch 4. **1st rnd:** 11 dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped ch-3 counts as dc). Join with sl st to top of ch-3. 12 dc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each dc around. Join with sl st to first sc. 24 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew onto Owl. Sew buttons onto Eyes as seen in picture.

#### **NOSE**


With D, ch 5.

**1st row:** 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew onto Owl.

# FEET

Pompom (make 4)

Wind D around 4 fingers approx 60 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape. Sew 2 Pompoms to bottom of each Owl as seen in picture.
