



 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48" x 60" [122 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

9 dc and 6 rows = 6" [15 cm] in
Basketweave Pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Basketweave Pattern (multiple of 10 + 3 for foundation row).

Ch 73.

Foundation row: (RS). 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn.

1st to 4th rows: Ch 2 (counts as dc here and throughout). *1 dcbp around each of next 5 sts. 1 dcfp around each of next 5 sts. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

5th to 8th rows: Ch 2. *1 dcbp around each of next 5 sts. 1 dcbp around each of next 5 sts. Rep from * to last st. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

Rep 1st to 8th rows for Basketweave Pat until work from beg measures approx 60" [152.5 cm], ending on 4th or 8th row of pat. **Do not** turn at end of last row.

FINISHING

With RS facing, work sc evenly around, having 2 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.3 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) or (5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)

Main Color (MC) Red or Cranberry (00705) **825 yds/750 m or 4 (8) balls**

Size U.S. N/13 (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
