CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

 $\mathbf{Dc} = \text{Double crochet}$ 

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Dcfp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**SI st** = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Velvet Plus™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 78 yds/71 m)

Pink Dusk (56005)

12 balls

Size U.S. NP/15 (10 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 42" x 60" [106.5 x 152.5 cm].

## **GAUGE**

6 sts and 4 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

#### **Notes:**

- · Pat is worked over any oddnumber multiplied by 3 + 4 ch.
- Ch 2 at beg of row counts as st..
- The first first dcfp or dcbp of row is worked around the second post in the row below, not the



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post that lines up under the turning chain.

#### Ch 67.

**1st row:** 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc.) 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 65 sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. \*1 dcfp around each of next 3 sts. 1 dcbp around each of next 3 sts. Rep from \* to last 4 sts. 1 dcfp around each of next 3 sts. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. \*1 dcbp around each of next 3 sts. 1 dcfp around each of next 3 sts. Rep from \* to last 4 sts. 1 dcbp around each of next 3 sts. 1 dc in last st. Turn.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until work from beg measures approx 56" [142 cm].

#### Note:

Hannah recommends that when it is necessary to join a new skein, that you do so at the beg of a new row. You can then knot the tails tog before weaving in ends.

#### **Border:**

**1st rnd:** Join yarn with sl st to any corner. Ch 2. Work in hdc evenly around perimeter of Throw, working sts in between dc posts along top and bottom, and working sts in between rows along sides, and working 3 hdc in each corner. Join with sl st to first st.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 2. Work 1 hdc in between each st around. working 2 hdc on either side of every corner st. Join with sl st to first st. 1 hdc in each st around.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 2. Work 1 hdc in between each st around. working 3 hdc in each corner. Join with sl st to first st. Fasten off.
