MEASUREMENTS

Approx 26 x 60" [66 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGES

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

9 sc and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

FRONT AND BACK (make 2 alike)
With larger hook and A, ch 48.

Bottom Section:

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same ch as prev sc, then into each of next 2 ch. *Ch 1. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same ch as last leg of prev sc3tog, then into each of next 2 ch. Rep from * to end of chain. 1 sc in same ch as last leg of prev sc3tog. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same place as prev sc, then into top of next sc3tog, then into next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same place as last

MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast A Blueberry Sprinkles (04870) **5 balls or 1135 yds/1038 m**

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Contrast B Taupe (10029) **3 balls or 480 yds/439 m**

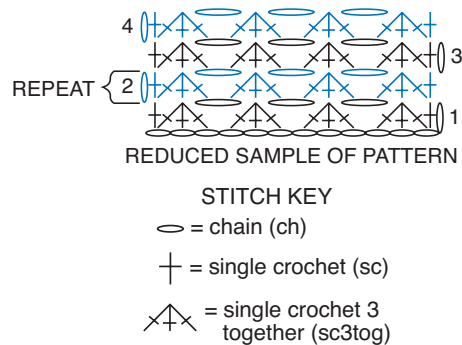
Bernat® Blanket™ (5.3 oz/150 g; 108 yds/98 m)

Contrast D Cranberry (00705) **1 ball or 22 yds/20 m**

Sizes U.S. K/10.5 (6.5 mm) and U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 20 yds/18 m of chunky weight black yarn for embroidery. 3 queen size pillows 20" x 26" [51 x 66 cm]. Stitch markers. Yarn needle.

leg of prev sc3tog, then into top of next sc3tog, then into next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to end of row, working 3rd leg of last sc3tog into last sc. 1 sc in same sc as last leg of last sc3tog. Turn.

Rep 2nd row for Trinity Stitch Pat. (See diagram).



Cont in pat until work from beg measures 20" [51 cm], ending on a WS row.

Next row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each st and ch-1 sp to end of row. Turn. Place marker at end of row.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Middle Section: Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same st as prev sc, then into each of next 2 sc. *Ch 1. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same sc as last leg of prev sc3tog, then into each of next 2 sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in same sc as last leg of prev sc3tog. Turn.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same place as prev sc, then into top of next sc3tog, then into next ch-1 sp. *Ch 1. Sc3tog, inserting hook first into same place as prev sc, then into top of next sc3tog, then into next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to end of row, working 3rd leg of last sc3tog into last sc. 1 sc in same sp as last leg of last sc3tog. Turn.

Rep last row for Trinity Stitch Pat until same number of rows as Bottom Section has been worked, ending on a WS row. Break A. Join B.

Next row: (RS). With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each st and ch-1 sp to end of row. Turn. Place marker at end of row.

Next row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Upper Section: Cont even in sc until work from last marker measures approx 20" [51 cm], ending on a WS row. Fasten off.

Create pillow dividers: Place Front and Back tog with WS facing each other and edges aligned. With Front facing and larger hook, join A with sl st at edge of work at 1st marked row (between Bottom and Middle Sections). Join Front to Back along marked row using sl st through both thicknesses. Rep for 2nd marked row (between Middle and Top Sections).

Join edges: With Front facing and larger hook, join B with sl st through both thicknesses at 2nd marked row (between Middle and Top Sections).

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 1. Working through both thicknesses, (work sc evenly to corner. 3 sc in corner) twice. Insert pillow form in Upper Section. Work sc evenly to same marked row as last sl st. Join A. Break B. With A, cont working sc through both thickness around entire edge, having 3 sc in each corner and inserting pillow forms in Middle and Lower Sections before joining last edge. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.

Ears

With B and smaller hook, beg using magic loop method, as demonstrated [here](#).

1st row: Ch 1. 6 sc in ring. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. 12 sts.

3rd and alt rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next st. 2 sc in in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 18 sts.

5th row: As 3rd row.

6th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 24 sts.

7th row: As 3rd row.

8th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sts. 2 sc in in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 30 sts.

9th row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, *sc2tog, 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 24 sts.

10th row: As 3rd row. Break B. Join C.

11th row: With C, ch 1. *Sc2tog, 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 18 sts.

12th row: As 3rd row.

13th row: Ch 1. *Sc2tog, 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 12 sts.

14th row: As 3rd row.

15th row: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 6 sts.

16th row: Ch 1. (Sc3tog) twice. Fasten off.

Sew Ears to top of Pillow as shown in photo.

Bowtie

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

With D and smaller hook, ch 18. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring, being careful not to twist.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. Join. 18 sts.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

Rep 2nd rnd until work from beg measures 4" [10 cm].

Next rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog, 1 sc in next st. Rep from * around. Join. 12 sts.

Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

Next rnd: Ch 1. *Sc2tog, 1 sc in next st. Rep from * around. Join. 8 sts.

Next 4 rnds: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

Next rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * around. 12 sts.

Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

Next rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next st. 1 sc in next st. 18 sts. PM.

Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st around. Join.

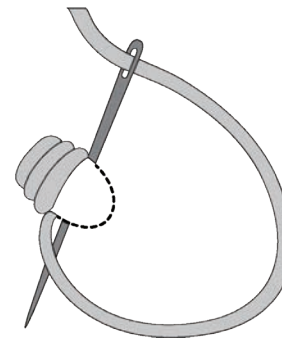
Rep last rnd until work from marked row measures 4" [10 cm].

Fasten off. Sew to Pillow as shown in photo.

Face

Using satin stitch for nose, and chain stitch for mouth and eyes, embroider Mouth and Eyes on Pillow with black yarn as shown in photo.
