



MATERIALS

Bernat® Alize® Blanket-EZ™ (6.4 oz/180 g; 18 yds/16 m)
Dark Gray (37014) **8 balls**

 CRAFT | SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE**

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 56" x 60" [142 x 152.5 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Right side of project is facing at all times.

Count 70 loops for foundation row (noting yarn end is far right and all loops are facing upwards).

1st row: Working from **left** to **right**, twist the 70th loop (last loop of foundation row) once to the left. Pull the 71st loop (from 'working yarn') up through 70th loop from behind to create a twisted stitch. Twist next loop once to the left (of foundation row). Pull next loop from working yarn up through next loop of foundation row. Continue in this manner to end of row. **Do not** turn work. 70 stitches in row.

2nd row: Working from **right** to **left** with working yarn in front, twist last stitch worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through last stitch worked on previous row. *Twist

next stitch once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch. Repeat from * across row to end of row.

Do not turn.

3rd row: Working from **left** to **right**, with working yarn in back, twist last stitch worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through last st worked on previous row. *Twist next stitch once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch. Repeat from * across to end of row. **Do not** turn.

4th row: As 2nd row.

Begin working in Cable pattern as follows:

5th row: Working from **left** to **right**, with working yarn in back, twist last stitch worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through last st worked on previous row. *Twist next stitch once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch.

Repeat from * 4 times more. (6 twisted stitches worked).
**Cross next stitch in front of 2nd stitch. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind 1st stitch. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind 2nd stitch. Rep from ** to last 6 stitches. Twist next stitch once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch over last 6 stitches.

6th row: Working from **right to left** with working yarn in front, twist last stitch worked on previous row once to the left. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through last stitch worked on previous row. *Twist next stitch once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch. Repeat from * 4 times more (6 twisted stitches worked). **Bring working yarn to back**, **Pull next loop from working yarn up from behind through next stitch. Repeat from ** to last 6 sts. **Bring working yarn to front**, *Twist next stitch once to left. Pull next loop from working yarn towards back through next stitch over last 6 stitches.

Repeat last 2 rows for pattern until Blanket measures approximately 56" [142 cm], ending on an 5th row.

Next row: As 2nd row.

Next row: As 3rd row.

Repeat last 2 rows once more.

Next row: As 2nd row.

Bind off row: Working in **same direction as last row**, pull 2nd stitch through 1st stitch. Pull 3rd stitch through 2nd stitch. Pull 4th stitch through 3rd stitch. Continue in this manner to end of row. Cut last loop to create a yarn 'tail'. Tie to secure and weave in end.
