

CARON CROCHET COLORBLOCK HAT

MATERIALS

Caron[®] Simply Soft[®] (Solids: 6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m; Heathers: 5 oz/141 q; 250 yds/228 m)

Contrast A Charcoal Heather (9508)

1 ball

Contrast B Watermelon (9604)

1 ball

Caron[®] Simply Soft[®] Tweeds[™] (5 oz/141 g; 240 yds/219 m)

Contrast C Off White Tweeds (23001)

1 ball

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.





CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through 3 loops on hook

Hdcfp = Yoh and draw up a look around post of next stitch at front of work, inserting hook from right to left. Yoh and draw through 3 loops on hook

Rem = Remain(ing)(s)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

SI st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZE

One size to fit Adult.

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 2 at beg of rnds does **not** count as a st.

With A, ch 70.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of ch. Turn, 68 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. *1 hdcfp around next hdc. 1 hdcbp around next hdc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. Rep 2nd row 6 times more.

Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Break A. Join B. Turn.

Work Chart (see page 2), noting each square of chart is equal to 1 sc and reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right. **Do not** carry color not in use across top of previous row.

CROCHET COLORBLOCK HAT

1st row: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 47 hdc. With C, 1 sc in each hdc to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: With C, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 22 sc. With B, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 45 sc. With C, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Cont working chart in sc until 22nd row of chart is complete. Break B and C. Join A.

Shape crown: 1st row: With A, ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 15 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 64 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 56 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 48 sc.

4th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 40 sc.

5th row: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 32 sc.


6th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 24 sc.

7th row: Ch 1.*Sc2tog. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 16 sc.

8th row: Ch 1. *Sc2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 8 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem sts and fasten securely. Sew center back seam.





Start here
