



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** =

Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Hdc** = Half double  
crochet

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**Sl st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

**WS** = Wrong side

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" x 70" [20.5 x 178 cm],  
excluding pompoms.

## GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Notes:** Scarf is worked lengthwise.  
Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count  
as st.

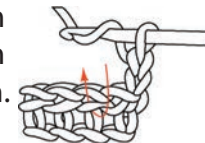
With MC, ch 212.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from  
hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of  
chain. Turn. 210 sts.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. *Work in horizontal  
bar only at front of work, created  
by hdc (see diagram  
above), 1 hdc in each  
st to end of row. Turn.*

Rep last row until work from beg  
measures 8" [20.5 cm]. Fasten off.

**Pompoms:** (Make 4). Wind  
1 strand each of A and B around  
2 fingers 40 times. Tie tightly in  
the middle and leave a long end  
for attaching to Scarf. Cut loops  
at both ends and trim to smooth  
round shape.



## MATERIALS

**Caron® Simply Soft®** (6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m)

**Main Color (MC)** Country Blue (9710)      **2 balls**

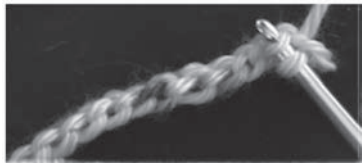
**Contrast A** Dark Country Blue (9711)      **1 balls**

**Contrast B** Off White (9702)      **1 balls**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

**Cord:** With B, make chain 20"  
[51 cm] long.

**1st row:** Sl st in each back bump of  
2nd ch from hook and in each ch  
to end of chain. Fasten off.



Fold Scarf in half with short ends  
and WS tog. On RS and beg at  
center of one end, approx 4"  
[10 cm] above short edge of Scarf,  
thread cord through sts as shown  
in picture. Work to side of first end,  
across RS of other end, and back to  
center of first end. Pull tightly to  
gather fabric of Scarf. Tie ends in  
a bow. Sew pompom to each end  
of cord.
