**Contrast A** Country Blue (9710)

3 balls

**Contrast B** White (9701)

2 balls

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Tapestry needle.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dcbp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Dcfp** = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front **Yoh** = Yarn over hook

of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**SI st** = Slip stitch

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 29" x 34" [73.5 x86.5 cm].

## **GAUGE**

15 hdc and 12 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in pat.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Notes:** Pat is worked over a multiple of 10 ch + 9.

Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

To change colors, work to last 3 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 3 loops and 1st rnd: (RS). Ch 3. Work 1 rnd of proceed with new color. Carry yarn not in use across top of previous row and work sts around it to prevent stranding. Ch 2 at beg of row/rnd does not count as st.

With A, ch 99.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd chain \* around. from hook. 1 hdc in each of next **Note:** When you work corners, 6 ch. \*With B, 1 hdc in each of next you will maintain cont of (1 dcfp. 3 ch. With A, 1 hdc in each of next 1 dcbp) st pat while working 3 sts 7 ch. Rep from \* to end of ch. Turn. around corner sts. You will work 97 hdc.

2nd to 7th rows: Ch 2. \*With A, (1 dcbp 1 dcfp. 1 dcbp) around 1 hdc in each of next 7 sts. With B. 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from **3rd rnd:** Ch 2. Keeping cont of \* to end of row. Turn.

in each st. **Note:** Cont to carry color corner st. Join with sl st to first dc. A along top of work. Turn.

**10th to 16th rows:** Ch 2. \*With A. desired width. Fasten off. 1 hdc in each of next 7 sts. With B, 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

Rep rows 8th to 16th rows until work from beg measures approx 31" [79 cm], ending on a 16th row. Fasten off.

#### Border

Join A with a sl st to any corner.

dc evenly around Blanket, working 3 dc in each corner. Join with sl st to first dc.

Note: You will work 1 dc per row of hdc along the left and right sides of Blanket.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. \*1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from

either (1 dcfp. 1 dcbp. 1 dcfp) or corner sts to maintain cont of pat. dcfp/dcbp pat, work 1 st into each 8th to 9th rows: Ch 2. With B, 1 hdc st around, working 3 sts into each Rep 3rd rnd until border reaches

> Weave in any ends with a tapestry needle.
