CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front

of work, inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 29" x 34" [73.5 x 86.5 cm].

GAUGE

15 hdc and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Pat is worked over a multiple of 10 ch + 9.

Ch 2 at beg of row **does not** count as st.

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast A Country Blue (9710) **3 balls**

Contrast B White (9701) **2 balls**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Tapestry needle.

To change colors, work to last 3 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 3 loops and proceed with new color. Carry yarn not in use across top of previous row and work sts around it to prevent stranding. Ch 2 at beg of row/rnd **does not** count as st.

With A, ch 99.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd chain from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 6 ch. *With B, 1 hdc in each of next 3 ch. With A, 1 hdc in each of next 7 ch. Rep from * to end of ch. Turn. 97 hdc.

2nd to 7th rows: Ch 2. *With A, 1 hdc in each of next 7 sts. With B, 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

8th to 9th rows: Ch 2. With B, 1 hdc in each st. **Note:** Cont to carry color A along top of work. Turn.

10th to 16th rows: Ch 2. *With A, 1 hdc in each of next 7 sts. With B, 1 hdc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep rows 8th to 16th rows until work from beg measures approx 31" [79 cm], ending on a 16th row. Fasten off.

Border

Join A with a sl st to any corner.

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 3. Work 1 rnd of dc evenly around Blanket, working 3 dc in each corner. Join with sl st to first dc.

Note: You will work 1 dc per row of hdc along the left and right sides of Blanket.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcfp around next st. 1 dcbp around next st. Rep from * around.

Note: When you work corners, you will maintain cont of (1 dcfp. 1 dcbp) st pat while working 3 sts around corner sts. You will work either (1 dcfp. 1 dcbp. 1 dcfp) or (1 dcbp 1 dcfp. 1 dcbp) around corner sts to maintain cont of pat.

3rd rnd: Ch 2. Keeping cont of dcfp/dcbp pat, work 1 st into each st around, working 3 sts into each corner st. Join with sl st to first dc. Rep 3rd rnd until border reaches desired width. Fasten off.

Weave in any ends with a tapestry needle.
