MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Velvet™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 492 yds/450 m)

Main Color (MC) Misty Gray (86016)2 ballsContrast A Tiny Teal (86003)1 ballContrast B Potpourri (86029)1 ballContrast C Snapdragon Yellow (86050)1 ball

Contrast D Bleached Aqua (86030) 1 ball

Contrast E Orchid Hush (86005) 1 ball

Contrast F Cuddly Cloud (86018) 1 ball

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Dcbp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at back of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice

Dcfp = Yoh and draw up a loop around post of next stitch at front of work inserting hook from right to left. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice

Hdc = Half double crochet

Whdc = (Wide Half Double Crochet) Yoh and draw up a loop in space between stitches of previous row. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 30" x 42" [76 x 106.5 cm]

GAUGE

16 whdc and 14 rows = 4'' [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

 Ch 2 at beg of row/rnd does not count as st.




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- To change colors, work to last 3 loops on hook of first color. Draw and proceed with new color.
- To avoid yarn getting twisted as it is carried along top of work, keep one color to the front and one color to the back each time vou switch colors.
- When turning to a new row, wrap the color not in use around the side of your work and continue to crochet over it as you go.
- Insert hook underneath yarn you carried on the previous row.

With MC, ch 107 (pattern rep is a multiple of 6 ch + 5).

1st row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of row. Turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 2. In the first sp to the left of post, 1 whdc. 1 whdc in each sp to end of row, placing final whdc between last st and turning ch. Turn.



4th to 11th rows: Ch 2. With MC, new color through last 2 loops *With A, work 1 whdc into each of 1 dcbp) st pat while working 3 sts the next 3 sps, crocheting over the MC as you work. With MC, 1 whdc in each of next 3 sps, crocheting over A as you work. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

> 12th to 14th rows: Ch 2. With MC. 1 whdc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep 4th to 14th rows for remainder of Blanket, switching to a new color each time you repeat rows 4 through 11, cycling through the color order as arranged in the Materials List, and ending on a 14th row.

Border

With RS facing, join MC with sl st to any corner sp.

1st rnd: Ch 2. Work 1 rnd of dc evenly around perimeter of Blanket, working 3 dc into each corner sp. Join with sl st to first dc.

Note: You will work 1 dc per row of hdc along the left and right sides of Blanket.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. *1 dcbp around next st. 1 dcfp around next st. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first st.

Note: When you work corners, work 1 whdc in each of first 3 sps. you will maintain cont of (1 dcfp. around corner sts. You will work either (1 dcfp. 1 dcbp. 1 dcfp) or (1 dcbp. 1 dcfp. 1 dcbp) around corner sts.

3rd rnd: As 2nd rnd.

Note: You should work all dcfp from previous rnd as dcfp, and work all dcbp from previous rnd as dcbp.

4th rnd: As 3rd rnd. Fasten off.

Weave in all ends with yarn needle.
