#### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Baby Blanket™** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

**Contrast A** Baby Pink (03200) **2 balls or 290 yds/265 m** 

**Contrast B** Baby Peach (03512) **1 ball or 135 yds/124 m** 

Contrast C Baby Yellow (03615) 1 ball or 75 yds/69 m

**Contrast D** Seafoam (03736) **1 ball or 110 yds/100 m** 

**Contrast E** Baby Blue (03202) **1 ball or 150 yds/137 m** 

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 14½" [35.5] diameter x 14½" [35.5] high.

### **GAUGE**

7 sc and 7 rows = 4" [10 cm] with 2 strands of yarn held together.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Note:** Join all rnds with sl st to first sc.

With 2 strands of A held tog, ch 2. **1st rnd:** 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.

**3rd rnd:** Ch 1. \*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 24 sc.

**4th rnd:** Ch 1.\*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 32 sc.

**5th rnd:** Ch 1.\*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 40 sc.

**6th rnd:** Ch 1.\*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 48 sc.

**7th rnd:** Ch 1.\*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 56 sc.

**8th rnd:** Ch 1.\*2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Rep from \* around. Join. 64 sc.

**9th to 13th rnds:** Cont in this manner, inc 8 sc evenly around (as established). 104 sc at end of 13th rnd.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Place marker at end of rnd.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. Working in both loops, 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join.

Rep last rnd twice more, joining B at end of last rnd.

With B, rep last rnd 5 times, joining C at end of last rnd.

With C, rep last rnd 5 times, joining D at end of last rnd.

With D, rep last rnd 5 times, joining E at end of last rnd.

With E, rep last rnd twice.

### Next rnd (Handle openings):

Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 21 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 42 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of rnd. Join.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc and ch-1 sp around. Join.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join. Fasten off.

**Handles:** With 2 strands of E held tog, ch 26.

Thread chain through first ch-1 sp of Handle opening rnd and back out through second ch-1 sp of same rnd. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring, being careful not to twist.

**Next rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around, rotating chain through Handle opening for ease of working. Join. Fasten off. Rep for second Handle.
