



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**K** = Knit

**K2(3)tog** = Knit next 2(3) stitches together

**M1L** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch from front to back and knitting into back of loop.

**M1R** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch from back to front and knitting into front of loop

**Pat** = Pattern

**P** = Purl

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**Ss(s)k** = Slip next 2(3) stitches knitwise, one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through the back loops together.

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**RS** = Right side

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" x 10" [20.5 x 25.5 cm].

## GAUGE

19 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Seed St Pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### LEMON

With MC, cast on 3 sts.

Working in Seed St Pat, proceed as follows:

(See Chart on page 3)

**1st row:** (RS). Cast on 1 st. \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

**2nd row:** Cast on 1 st. \*P1. K1. Rep from \* to end of row.

Last 2 rows form Seed St Pat.



## MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

**Main Color (MC)** Sunshine (00073) **1 ball or 70 yds/64 m**

**Contrast A** Mod Green (01223) **1 ball or 8 yds/7 m**

Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Black embroidery thread for eyes and mouth. Embroidery needle.



Keeping cont of seed st pat, proceed as follows:

**3rd to 5th rows:** Cast on 2 sts. Pat to end of row. 10 sts at end of 5th row.

**6th to 9th rows:** Cast on 3 sts. Pat to end of row. 22 sts at end of 9th row.

**10th row:** Cast on 2 sts. Pat to end of row. 24 sts at end of 10th row.

**11th to 19th rows:** Cast on 1 st. Pat to end of row. 33 sts at end of 19th row.

**20th row:** Work even in pat.

**21st and 22nd rows:** Cast on 1 st. Pat to end of row. 35 sts at end of 22nd row.

**23rd and 24th rows:** Work even in pat.

**25th and 26th rows:** Cast on 1 st. Pat to end of row. 37 sts at end of 26th row.

**27th and 28th rows:** Work even in pat.

**29th and 30th rows:** Cast on 1 st. Pat to end of row. 39 sts at end of 30th row.

**31st to 44th rows:** Work even in pat.

**45th and 46th rows:** Cast off 1 st. Pat to end of row. 37 sts at end of 46th row.

**47th and 48th rows:** Work even in pat.

**49th and 50th rows:** Cast off 1 st. 35 sts at end of 50th row.

**51st and 52nd rows:** Work even in pat.

**53rd and 54th rows:** Cast off 1 st. 33 sts at end of 54th row.

**55th and 56th rows:** Work even in pat.

**57th row:** Cast off 1 st. 32 sts.

**58th:** Work even in pat.

**59th to 65th rows:** Cast off 1 st. 24 sts at end of 65th row.

**66th to 69th rows:** Cast off 2 sts. 16 sts at end of 69th row.

**70th and 71st rows:** Cast off 3 sts. 10 sts at end of 71st row.

**72nd to 74th rows:** Cast off 2 sts. 4 sts at end of 74th row.

**75th row:** Cast off 1 st. 3 sts.

**76th row:** Work even in pat. Cast off rem 3 sts.

### LEAF

With A, cast on 3 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K1. M1R. K1. M1L. K1. 5 sts.

**2nd and alt rows:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K2. M1R. K1. M1L. K2. 7 sts.

**5th row:** K3. M1R. K1. M1L. K3. 9 sts.

**7th row:** K4. M1R. K1. M1L. K4. 11 sts.

**9th row:** K5. M1R. K1. M1L. K5. 13 sts.

**11th and 13th rows:** ssk. K5. M1R. K1. M1L. K5. K2tog. 13 sts.

**15th row:** (ssk) twice. K2. M1R. K1. M1L. K2. (K2tog) twice. 11 sts.

**17th row:** (ssk) twice. K1. M1R. K1. M1L. K1. (K2tog) twice. 9 sts.

**19th row:** (ssk) twice. M1R. K1. M1L. (K2tog) twice. 7 sts.

**21st row:** sssk. Kfb. K1. Kfb. K3tog. 5 sts.

**23rd row:** ssk. K1. K2tog. 3 sts.

**25th row:** K3tog.

Fasten off. Sew Leaf to top of Lemon.

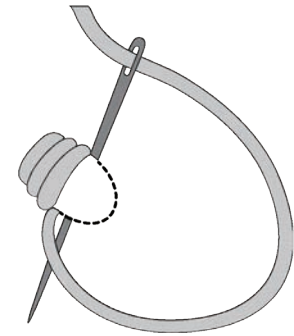
### Hanging Loop

With A, cast on 15 sts. Cast off.

Fold Loop in half and sew to top of Lemon.

### FINISHING

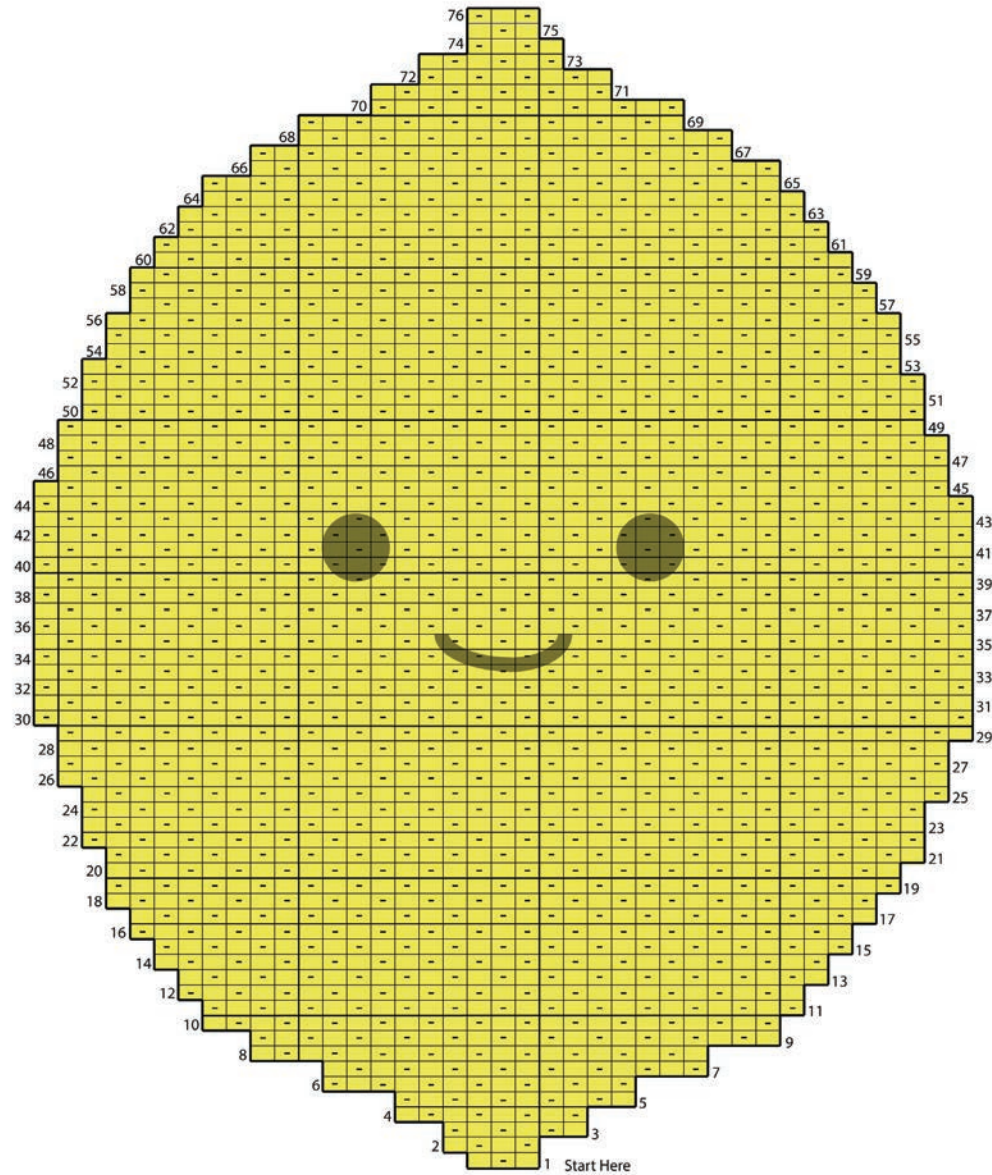
With Black embroidery thread, embroider eyes using satin stitch and mouth using chain st, using chart as guide.
