



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

K = Knit

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

K3togtbl = Knit next 3 stitches together through back loops

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)(s)

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1Pwyib = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in back of work

Sl1Pwyif = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn in front of work

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarn over

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14½" x 49" (37 x 124.5 cm).

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Dotted Pat.

17 sts and 30 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Use MC as Color 1 throughout.
- Every row is worked with one color only.

- Carry yarn when not in use loosely up side of work, taking Color 2 from behind Color 1, being careful not to twist strands, when changing yarns at beg of row.
- When slipping sts, hold yarn in back of work on RS and yarn in front of work on WS.
- When carrying yarn behind/in front of slipped sts, be sure yarn is loose enough to maintain gauge and prevent work from puckering.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® Super Size (4 oz/113 g; 190 yds/174 m)

Main Color (MC) Ecreu (18004) **2 balls or 370 yds/336 m**

Contrast A Overcast (18042) **1 ball or 120 yds/109 m**

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast B Tea Rose (00042) **1 ball or 110 yds/100 m**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle. 4" [10 cm] piece of cardboard for tassels.



Dotted Pat (multiple of 2 sts + 3):

1st to 4th rows: With Color 1, work 4 rows in stocking st, noting first row is RS.

5th row: With Color 2, K1. Sl1Pwyib. *(K1. yo. K1) all in next st. Sl1Pwyib. Rep from * to last st. K1.

6th row: P1. *Sl1Pwyif. K3togtbl. Rep from * to last 2 sts. Sl1Pwyif. P1.

Dashed Pat (multiple of 3 sts + 7):

1st to 4th rows: With Color 1, work 4 rows in stocking st, noting first row is RS.

5th row: With Color 2, K3. Sl1Pwyib. *K2. Sl1Pwyib. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

6th row: K3. Sl1Pwyif. *K2. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.

RUNNER

Using long-tail cast on and A, cast on 58 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 3 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is RS.

Increase row: (WS). K9. Kfb. *K18. Kfb. Rep * to last 10 sts. K10. 61 sts.

Proceed as follows: Using A as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 5 times. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work Dashed Pat 4 times. Break B.

Using A as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 3 times. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work Dashed Pat twice. Break B.

Using A as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 3 times. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 4 times. Break B.

Using A as Color 2, work Dashed Pat 5 times. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 4 times. Break B.

Using A as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 3 times. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work Dashed Pat twice. Break B.

Using A as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 3 times. Break A.

Using B as Color 2, work Dashed Pat 4 times. Break B.

Using A as Color 2, work Dotted Pat 5 times.

With MC, work 4 rows in stocking st, noting first row is RS.

Next row: (RS). With A, knit.

Decrease row: (WS). K9. K2tog. *K18. K2tog. Rep to last 10 sts. K10. 58 sts.

Knit 2 rows (garter st). Cast off knitwise (RS).

Side edging:

Note: Pick up sts in spaces between first 2 sts and last 2 sts of Runner for a neat finish. First and last sts of Runner will be hidden by garter st edging.

With RS facing and A, pick up and knit 207 sts evenly across side edge of Runner.

Knit 2 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep along opposite side edge.

Tassels (make 4): Cut a piece of cardboard 4" [10 cm] wide. Wind A around cardboard 50 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew 1 Tassel to each corner as shown in picture.
